## **Important: Only One Driving Test Per Day**

## Driving Test Requirements:

- You must provide the vehicle for the driving test.
- Proof of personal injury protection/property damage insurance and valid vehicle registration must be provided on the vehicle for the driving test.
- If you do not have a valid license you must be accompanied by a licensed driver.
- You must be at least 16 years old.
- If you are 16 or 17 years old, you must have held a learner's license for at least one year without any traffic convictions, and present parent or guardian <u>certification</u> that you have at least 50 hours of behind the wheel driving experience, of which 10 hours must be at night.
- No one may accompany you and the examiner(s) during the driving test.
