## Effective September 1<sup>st</sup> Vehicle Registration Fees will be Reduced

If your vehicle registration expires on the 1<sup>st</sup> of September or within the first week of September, here is what you need to know:

- The fees on the notice reflect the reduced rate that take effect September 1<sup>st</sup>
- Offices are closed September 1<sup>st</sup> in observance of Labor Day, so renewals received by mail MUST be held until September 2<sup>nd</sup> for processing
- The reduced rates will be available online beginning 12 AM on September 1<sup>st</sup>, and for inperson processing beginning September 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Motorist who are stopped by law enforcement whose registrations expire during the first week of September may be responsible for any citations that are received
- Renewals processed prior to September 1<sup>st</sup> will pay the current higher rates
- <u>Senate Bill 156</u> does not create a right to a refund
